



YOUR CHILD'S HISTORY FROM BIRTH TO GRADUATION

1. **Under-Bed Box** = This box is your child's treasure chest. It has limited storage so be very selective. Collect and store preferred memorabilia such as:
 - A favorite toy
 - A favorite item of clothing
 - A pair of baby shoes
 - Scouting Bandello
 - Award Ribbons
 - Trophy
 - Etc.
2. **Portable Hanging File Box** = There are 2 types of school papers you should keep. Those that are 1) your child's firsts & bests and 2) will be beneficial for future portfolios or resumes. Organize all saved paper type items into a loose chronological order. One box per child. Be sure to mark each piece with your child's name or initials and age. Labeling options include, but are not limited to:
 - Birth ↔ Preschool
 - Kindergarten ↔ Third Grades
 - Fourth ↔ Sixth Grades
 - Middle School Grades
 - High School Grades
 - Report Cards
 - Awards & Certificates
 - Cards & Letters
 - Sacred
 - Scouting
 - Etc.
3. **Photo Album** = Pictures are contained in a photo album of your choice and labeled as time permits either chronologically or by topical categories.

The above noted containers can be presented and looked through at a "This was your life" party within a month of your child's high school graduation. Reminisce about the good ol' days together and celebrate your graduate's hopes of days to come.
